



EASY ELASTICATED SKIRT



MY MEASUREMENTS ARE:

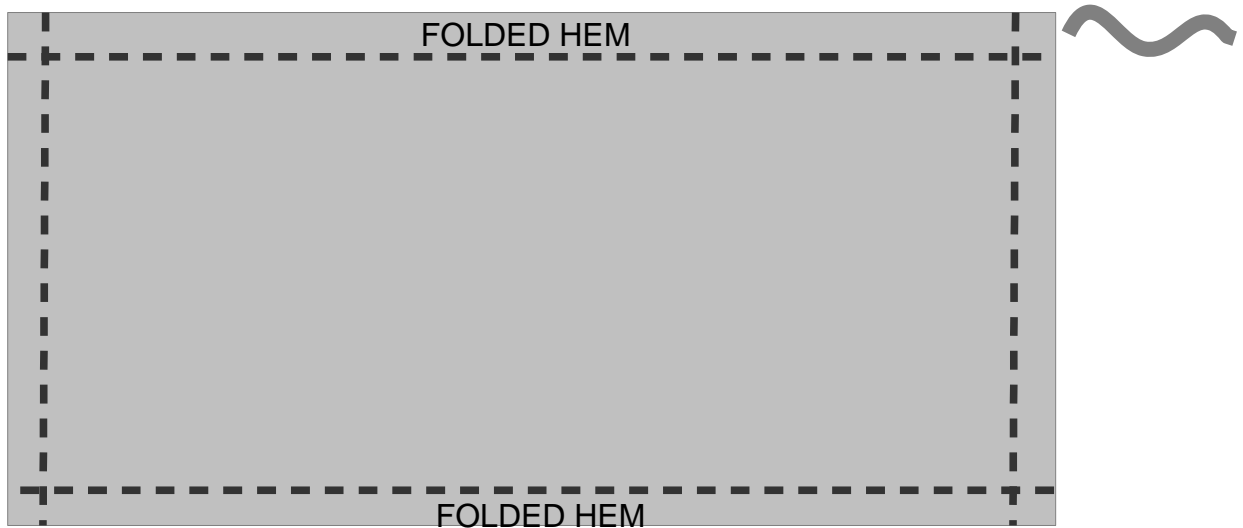
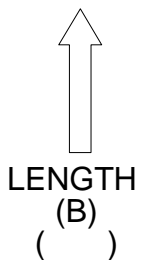
CMS

WAIST MEASUREMENT(CMS) X 2	= A	
LENGTH (CMS)+ 8 cm (for hem and waistband)	= B	

So you need 2 pieces (front and back) measuring width (A) by length (B)

(nb:If your fabric width is 150cm you could use one one strip folded).

Use 1.5cm width of elastic approx the measurement of your waist.



Cut your 2 rectangle pieces to required size.

Lay one piece on top on the other with right sides facing.

Stitch down either side seam with a 1cm seam allowance.

Finish edges with a zig zag or pinking shears. Press seam open.

Fold over top long edge 1cm then again 3cm. Press.

Stitch all around top edge close to fold. Leave an opening for inserting elastic.

Thread elastic with a safety pin. Join together at correct size.

Sew up opening.

Turn up hem 1cm then again 3cm, pin, then stitch all around close to fold. Wear with pride!
