
How to Make a Pinny by Sewgirl


Suggested dimensions= Pinny 85cm x 50cm Waistband = 50cm x 10cm. Ties = 85cm x 2.5cm




Hem sides and bottom edge. Set to longest stitch length and loosest tension on machine, then sew across 6mm in from top edge. Leave long threads at each side.




Tie a knot at one side, pull thread at other side to gather stitches. Knot at opposite side to secure gathering.




Fold a rectangle over on each long side 1cm, then fold over in half, press. Lay gathered piece on top of opened waistband in centre with right sides facing each other. Pin, tack, then sew across.



Turn apron over so right side facing, trim waistband to 1.5cm over hang each side, lay in ties as shown.



Fold waistband over, sandwiching in ties at each side. Pin, then sew each side as shown.



Fold waistband to right side, push out corners, then hand or machine sew opening at back.
